**Carpentry Shop Report**  
**Fiscal Year – 2004/05**

Some very important changes have occurred in the shop during the past year. Most importantly it was substantially enlarged making for much more efficient and convenient working conditions. Almost as important was the installation of double doors, which means we will be less likely to build set pieces and then find we can't get them out of the shop. New racks were constructed in the shop for storage of various sizes and types of lumber, trim, plywood, etc. making for easier access to needed material.

We have a steady and dedicated work force consisting of Harold Woodward, Rick Harvey, Rod McLeod, Barry Uncles, Harvey Friess, Pat Wilson and myself. We have constructed sets for RLT[five mainstage, two set one-acts & a fundraiser], RSS[major musical] and Lyric Light Opera[major musical]. We have also undertaken some of the renovations done to our rented space and a number of small projects for Theatre Regina, operators of the Performing Arts Centre. All in all it was an extremely busy year. Our hope is that the new year will be just a little bit less busy and stressful.
