**Front of House Report**

Front of House managed the concession for the:  
Main Stage Performances (5)  
One Act Plays  
Memories of Western Swingin' and Country Singin'

The first two Main Stage Performances were managed by Patrick Pelletier. The balance of the 2004 – 2005 season was managed by Cathy Moberly.

The concession included: Cookies, coffee, juice, water and pop. This was the first year that pop was sold and was successful addition.

Following is a summary of the Revenue and Expenses generated by Front of House:

Included in the total revenue indicated is \$139.51 received from the bottle and juice box recycling program. Average sales for the Main Stage Performances was \$571.84.

Inventory remaining on hand at the end of the 2004-2005 season totaled \$71.83.

The average cost of juice has risen to approximately \$.41 per box. It is recommended that the sale price for juice be increased to \$1.00 per box for the 2005-2006 season. This is the same sale price as the other beverages.
