

Volunteer Party Report – September 6, 2005

The first annual Volunteer Appreciation Party was held on Saturday June 25, 2005. The party was organized by the Extreme Makeover committee, which is a subcommittee of the RLT Board. A total of 135 invitations were sent out to RLT volunteers and their significant others. Regrets were received from 23 volunteers. RSVPs were received from 42 people, plus 12 significant others, for a total of 54 people. There was a total of 49 people in attendance at the party (40 volunteers plus 9 significant others). There were 11 no shows and 8 new/not confirmed volunteers in attendance. The board handed out 36 Lt. Governor's Appreciation of the Arts pins.

Bar service was offered at the party with prices reduced from \$4 to \$3 for drinks. There was a total of \$192 in sales. Thanks to Dana Wilson for helping in the bar.

The cost for the party was as follows:

The total cost for the volunteer party was \$390.27.

Given the number of attendees (despite the short notice) and the feedback received from them, the Board considers the party to be a success and looks forward to making it an annual RLT tradition.
