The three have been meeting once a month at the cemetery where they “check in” with their husbands. Then Sam the butcher comes on the scene and expresses a romantic interest in Ida. Laughter abounds as Doris and Lucille work to discourage the new romance, each for their own personal reasons.

The play features the talents of three RLT veterans as the main characters: Nora Berg, Dallas Castle and Sophie Yannitsos. “Having such talented and dedicated actors is a delight,” said director Warren James. “They have worked hard to develop complex and interesting characters, each with their own unique personalities and agendas.”

James himself is no stranger to the RLT stage, having last performed in *The Shipbuilder* (Fall, 2005). He also wrote and directed the one-act play *Draug* (Fall, 2004). “I decided to direct *The Cemetery Club* because my mother, who is confined to a nursing home, would have loved the show,” James said. “And she would’ve made a great Lucille.”
